* How about mandatory vocational study in years 10 & 11?



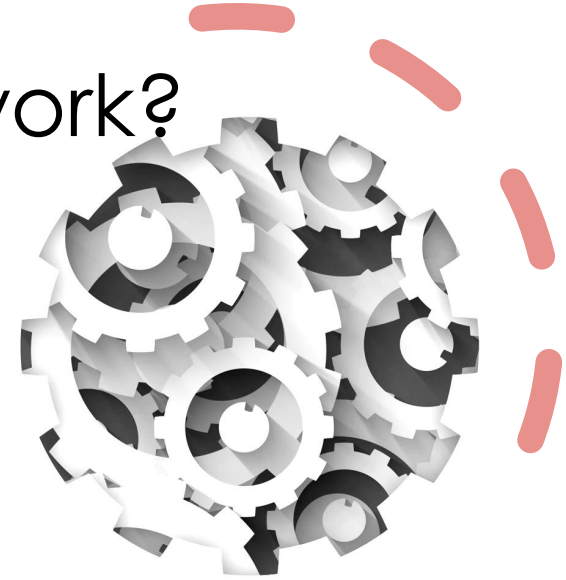
Why do we need an online library?

- The role of the Library is to signpost UK skills & training courses from Colleges, Universities and other training providers, to create the

life-long learning and career pathways

How does a library get people into work?

- Simple answer, by signposting **lifelong learning** courses, either before or because of being employed.
- Linked to the library will be an employment unit, helping to prepare and place people into work.
- The EEA employment unit, will connect with the training providers, candidates, and employers, to offer **career pathways**.

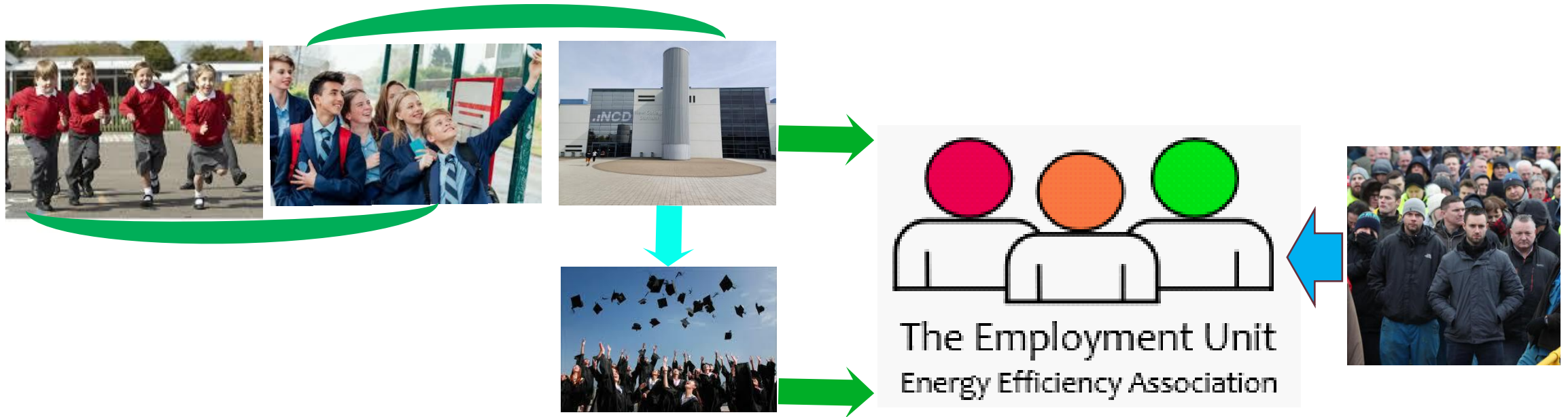
